## WHAT IS THE APPLICATION PROCESS?

Applications for our 2025 Internship Program open on 18 August 2024.

1. Apply via Seek, UWA, Curtin, ECU and Careers Hub, or on the Moore Australia website through the QR code
2. Upload your cover letter, resume and your most recent academic transcripts. **Tip: we want to hear details of your extracurricular or volunteer experience.**
3. Complete pre-screening interview and online assessment(s).
4. If shortlisted you will be invited to attend a panel interview.
5. Once all stages of the recruitment process are finalised, successful candidates will receive a formal offer.
